Title: Lift Mechanic Department: 11

Reporting Level: Lift Maintenance Manager

Job Qualifications: MUST BE 18 YEARS OF AGE; High School Diploma or equivalent preferred, lift maintenance experience preferred. Mechanical aptitude, knowledge of tools and the ability to work at heights/climb ladders, work in adverse weather conditions in an Alpine environment, and the ability to work well with others. Knowledge of ANSI B-77 codes, NDT certification, welding skills, metal fabrication skills, and rigging skills are a plus.

Essential Job Functions:

- Perform in compliance with Mt. Ashland policies and procedures as outlined in Mt. Ashland's Employee Handbook and Lift Department Handbook.
- Perform regular maintenance of lifts to ensure the highest quality of safety and operation.
- Morning lift start-up and pre-operational inspections.
- Accurately complete all lift maintenance logs and paperwork.
- Daily lift checks.
- Use appropriate PPE at all times.
- Service fixed grip Riblet Lifts/Chairs/Clips in entirety.
- Service fixed grip Yan Lifts/Chairs/Grips in entirety.
- Service fixed grip SkyTrac Lifts/Chairs/Grips in entirety.
- Service Sunkid conveyor in entirety.
- Engage/disengage APU on all lifts.
- Ski or snowboard to all lift terminals and towers with tools.
- Work with lift tensioning systems including counterweights.
- Work in a fast paced and sometimes high stress environment.
- Perform daily motor room checks, and post-operation shutdown procedures.
- Prepare lift(s) for opening and/or closing, including setting up and maintaining ramps, signs, mazes and posts, ropes, benches, and lift shacks.
- Operate a snowmobile in accordance with Mt Ashland's policies.
- Communicate effectively with guests and other Mt. Ashland departments and employees.
- Perform all duties with a focus on brilliant Guest Service.
- Perform other duties related to the position as directed by Lift Maintenance Manager.

Work safely at height. Climb ladders.
